



EXHIBITION - A Gallery of Maltese Architecture

Call for registration from architects and architectural firms

To commemorate World Architecture Day on 3rd October 2005, the Kamra tal-Periti, in collaboration with SACES, is organising **Time for Architecture** – a series of activities with an architectural theme.

The event will include an exhibition of works by Maltese architects and architectural firms at the Ministry of Tourism and Culture, Auberge D'Italie, Merchants Street Valletta, from 28th September to 9th October 2005. The objective is to give the opportunity to the profession to display works to a Maltese audience. It is hoped that the best of Maltese architecture would entice potential clients and the public in general to continuously aspire for better quality architecture.

Terms and Conditions

The timeline for registration and eventual submission is as follows:

05.09.2005	CLOSING DATE for submission of REGISTRATION + PAYMENT	Participating architects are to submit registration form together with preliminary visual information of the project (photos and/or plans). The text to be included on panel is also to be submitted. The relevant payment is to be made by cheque with registration(see registration form).
12.09.2005	CLOSING DATE for the submission of A3 PREVIEW of display panel.	The preview is to show the layout of the eventual A1 panel. The preview is to include sufficient information on the plans, photos and text that will be displayed to enable the Organising Committee to establish that the eventual A1 display is of sufficient quality.
13.09.2005 to 16.09.2005	Organising Committee will confirm which projects/ submissions are to be exhibited.	
23.09.2005	Submission of A1 styloboard panels	Details to be given at a later date
24.09.2005	Organising Committee to review and confirm acceptance of submitted panels	
26.09.2005	Mounting of exhibition	

Participation will be subject to the following conditions:

- This event is being organised by the Communications Standing Committee (hereafter referred to as the Organising Committee). The Kamra tal-Periti will appoint five members of the profession to assist the Organising Committee in assessing the quality of the projects submitted for inclusion in the exhibition.
- Choice of panels to be exhibited is at the discretion of the Organising Committee. It is presumed that architects wishing to exhibit will select projects which are worthy of being presented in a public exhibition. It is envisaged therefore that most submissions will be accepted. The Organising Committee may, however, exclude projects if (i) the project is of poor architectural quality; (ii) the design of the panel is considered to be poor; or (iii) if no preview is submitted. The organisers will make every effort to ensure that all submissions which meet the required standard be included in the exhibition. If, due to lack of space, this will not be possible, the Organising Committee may

have to exclude some submissions. The decision will be based on the architectural quality and the interest that the projects are likely to add to the exhibition. Their decision is final.

- The layout of the exhibition is strictly at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
- Only periti with a warrant to practice in Malta or warranted partnerships are eligible to participate in the exhibition. Projects involving the collaboration of foreign architects may be included. The names of both local and foreign collaborators are to be shown on the panel.
- **Projects are to be of high quality and standard and are to possess a high degree of architectural interest.**
- The preferred types of projects are those relating to buildings or structures (such as residential, commercial developments, restoration projects); other types of design projects will also be considered (landscaping, interior design, detailing of architectural components or furniture).
- Projects may be based locally or abroad.
- Projects submitted may be built or unbuilt, though preference will be given to completed projects; competition entries will also be considered.
- It is preferable for panels to include both drawings and photos/images of the project. The use of text on the panel is also encouraged, but this must be concise. The Organising Committee will prepare a standard format for the information as required above to be displayed. Exhibitors will be required to adhere to the standard format.
- No more than one project is to be displayed on each A1 panel. One form is to be filled in for every project to be displayed. The maximum number of projects to be displayed per architect/ architectural firm is FOUR; the maximum number of panels displayed is SIX.
- Participants may also exhibit a model, together with the panel/s for the project being displayed.
- Each panel is to display the following information: Project Title; Architect/architectural firm; Project Location; Client (may be kept anonymous if required); Project Commencement; Completion Date and Consultants.
- KTP does not take responsibility for any damage or loss of material submitted.
- After the exhibition, arrangements will be made for exhibitors to collect the panels. Panels not collected in accordance to arrangements set will be destroyed.

Registration

- A registration form is attached and is to be filled in and signed for each project. Payment is to be submitted by cheque made payable to the Kamra tal-Periti and attached to the registration form. Should one or more of the projects not be accepted for inclusion in the exhibition, the relevant amount will be refunded by the Organising Committee.
- The fee due for participation is of Lm 25 per A1 panel (up to a maximum of six panels as above)
- The registration form is to include a declaration by the participating perit that the information submitted is correct.
- Participants must be fully-paid up members of the Kamra tal-Periti, including all partners in the case of submissions by warranted partnerships.
- The fee for models is dependent on the size of the model. The fee applicable will be communicated to the participant soon after registration.
- Payment is to be submitted by cheque payable to the Kamra tal-Periti.
